**RE: Public Comment for the first meeting of the JISC**

Dear Gentlemen:

CARBON is project developer and applicant of CDM Methodology NM111, which has been approved by the CDM EB during its 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting in Montreal. We are financing, implementing and operating JI and CDM Projects mainly in the field of N<sub>2</sub>O destruction at nitric acid plants.

Project developers have interest to achieve equal project and emission certificate quality for ERUs and CERs. Therefore, we kindly ask the JISC to secure that the methodological requirement for JI-Projects are as strict as for CDM Projects. Weaker methodological requirements for JI-Project would have the automatic consequence that ERUs achieve a lower market price than CERs and this could bring a negative image to the total flexible instruments in general.

Consequently, project developers would warmly welcome to allow ERU trading only for those JI Projects which are based on CDM approved methodologies.
