**Ref: Call for public input on the establishment of a communication channel between the Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee and Joint Implementation project participants**


Honorable members of the Joint implementation Supervisory Committee,

We express our appreciation for the opportunity to provide our inputs on establishment of a communication channel between the JISC and Joint Implementation project participants.

We support the proposal for establishment of a communication channel that facilitates interactions between representatives of a group of project participants, project developers and the JISC at the JISC meetings. Such an additional communication channel with the JISC is a useful complement to the *Procedures for communication of the public with the Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee (Version 2)* adopted at the Fifteenth meeting of the JISC. A direct communication channel facilitates expression of views and concerns of a group of stakeholders and enables the JISC to provide clarifications on topics considered for discussion during the JISC meetings. Furthermore, representation of a group of stakeholders also facilitates a systematic follow-up on concerns raised and discussions initiated during the JISC meetings.

Taking into consideration of variations in nature and organizational types of the Joint Implementation project participants, we believe that a new communication channel will be most efficient if it includes a widest representation of stakeholders and ensures transparent principles and procedures for such a representation in the communication channel.
