## Request for clarification on Track switching and ITL number(s)

Dear Madam/Sir,

We are writing to submit a request for clarification regarding "Track switching" and respective ITL numbers.

Please confirm if we understand correctly that after the determination under Track 2 has been deemed final, it is still possible for project participants to switch to the national procedures under Track 1 for the verification and issuance of ERUs (as long as the Host country fulfils all requirements for Track 1 eligibility). Furthermore, is it correct that project participants may switch back to Track 2 for the verification and issuance of ERUs at any moment during the monitoring period?

Please also kindly confirm if we understand correctly that for such a "Track switching", project participants would need to have two ITL numbers. This is what we understood from the footnote at the JI project overview on the UNFCCC website: "\*\* Projects switching "Tracks" appear with different ITL project IDs." (e.g. for the Ukrainian projects under

We understand that one ITL number is needed for ERU transfer in case the verification is done under Track 2 and another ITL number is needed for ERU transfer in case the verification is done under Track 1.

Please kindly clarify the process of how projects participants can receive a second ITL number for Track 1 in case the project determination has been previously deemed final under Track 2.
