

REPORT OF THE JI ACCREDITATION PANEL (JI-AP)

Twenty-eighth meeting of the JI-AP

13 - 14 August 2012

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I. Introduction

1. This progress report covers the period from 4 February 2012 to 14 August 2012. During this period the Joint Implementation Accreditation Panel (JI-AP) held one meeting (JI-AP 28), on 13 - 14 August 2012.

II. Status of applications

2. The total number of entities currently under consideration by the JI-AP is 11, all of them being accredited independent entities (AIEs).

III. Case-specific issues

3. The JI-AP considered six additional focused on-site assessments. Recommendations on three cases will be submitted to the JISC under confidentiality.

4. The JI-AP considered two regular on-site surveillances of central offices and non-central sites. Notifications on two cases will be submitted to the JISC under confidentiality.

5. The JI-AP also considered three notifications on change. Recommendations on two cases will be submitted to the JISC under confidentiality.

IV. Update on work of the JI-AP

6. In line with the JI-AP workplan for 2012, the JI-AP held its second direct interaction with the clean development mechanism accreditation panel (CDM-AP). During the joint session the panels considered an update by the secretariat on the recent developments in the CDM and JI processes, including a briefing on implementation of a project to improve CDM accreditation system. In this context, the panels provided input on the alignment and on possible integration of the CDM and JI accreditation processes. The panels also provided input on the modalities of the accreditation panels' work and on the common SDM accreditation roster of experts.

V. Expert resources

7. The JI-AP considered a regular report on the qualifications and performance of the JI-AT leaders and members. The JI-AP agreed on a number of changes to the status of members on the accreditation roster of experts (AROE).

8. The JI-AP considered a status update and provided feedback to the secretariat on the development of an online training for the members of the AROE.

VI. Further schedule of the JI-AP

9. The dates for the next JI-AP meeting (JI-AP 29) are currently under discussion and will be defined based on the progress of the accreditation assessment cases.

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
