1. Procedural background

1. The Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee (JISC), at its thirty-second meeting, approved the workplan of the JISC for 2013 and requested the secretariat to include in future versions of the workplan any new mandates arising from meetings and to provide an update on the status of work at each meeting.
