**Letter of Approval**  
**for project under Article 6 of the Kyoto Protocol**  
**Joint Implementation**

Undersigned, as a legal and authorised representative of the Designated Focal Point for the Kingdom of Denmark under the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change,

Noting that the Danish Energy Agency has confirmed that they are a project participant in the proposed Joint Implementation project "Reduction of Methane Emissions at Flanged, Threaded Joints and Shutdown Devices of OJSC "Odesagas" Equipment";

Considering that the Project by repairing identified methane leaks is expected to provide a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by sources that is additional to any that would otherwise occur;

declares that:

1. Denmark has ratified the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on May 31, 2002, and participates voluntarily in the Joint Implementation Mechanism;
2. Denmark approves "Reduction of Methane Emissions at Flanged, Threaded Joints and Shutdown Devices of OJSC "Odesagas" Equipment" to be a Joint Implementation Mechanism project under Article 6 of the Kyoto Protocol and its underlying decisions;
3. Denmark approves and authorises the voluntary participation of the Danish Energy Agency in the Project;
