COVER NOTE

1. Procedural background

1. By its decision 7/CMP.11, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP) reiterated its request to the Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee (JISC) to ensure sufficient infrastructure and capacity for the mechanism's use by Parties for as long as needed, and to keep the joint implementation management plan under review, making necessary adjustments to ensure the efficient, cost-effective and transparent functioning of the joint implementation.

2. Purpose

2. The workplan of the JISC for 2016 provides an overview of the issues to be considered by the JISC at each meeting. This allows for the planning of the workload of the JISC for each JISC meeting and ensures efficient use of meeting time. The document indicates the work planned for the JISC at the meetings in 2016, based on the business plan and the management plan (JI MAP) for 2016–2017.

3. Key issues and proposed solutions

3. The workplan provides information on the type of products the JISC will consider at each meeting and actions to be taken by the JISC. Products to be considered by the JISC for implementing the recent mandates provided by the CMP at its eleventh session have also been incorporated in this plan.

4. Impacts

4. The workplan will ensure efficiency and transparency of the decision-making process and facilitate the management of the JISC workload.

5. **Proposed work and timelines**

5. It is proposed that the workplan be considered by the JISC at each meeting to take note of any updates resulting from new mandates of the JISC and the status of work during the year.

6. Recommendations to the Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee

6. The secretariat recommends that the JISC approve this draft workplan for 2016 and request the secretariat to update the workplan for the consideration of the JISC at each meeting, based on new mandates arising from the meetings and the status of work.
