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**Establishment of a DFP forum: roles and
how to make it effective for
the promotion of the mechanism**

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Background

Following the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), decision 4.CMP/6, which encourages the Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee (JISC) to enhance its interaction with designated focal points, independent entities and project participants, the JISC agreed at its twenty-fourth meeting (March 2011) to establish a **forum for designated focal points** (DFP Forum).

Other Forums in KP

- DOE/AIE Forum

established as a means to enhance the channels of **communication** between the CDM EB and DOEs and to **provide guidance** on decisions and clarifications on specific issues in a timely manner

- Registry System Administrators Forum - RSA Forum

Registry System Administrator Forum convened the in order to ensure that technical and management issues across registry systems are **effectively coordinated**. The Forum met for the first time in April 2006. In addition, groups are established under the Forum to conduct more detailed work in **preparing and implementing procedures of joint concern** to administrators of all registry systems.

- DNA Forum

established to promote **cooperation** and **exchanges of experiences** amongst designated national authorities (DNAs), with a view to building an adequate infrastructure for the CDM and overcoming other. The first meeting of the DNA Forum was held in Bonn in Oct 2006

DFP Forum Goals and Purpose

The purpose of the DFP Forum is:

- (a) A collaborative forum for DFPs to improve and promote JI;
- (b) A point of liaison for the JISC in relation to its work and national policy approaches;
- (c) A channel for capacity building exercises relating to JI.

The DFP Forum will also undertake other tasks requested by the JISC as appropriate, in accordance with its purpose

DFP Forum Roles

- Interact between each other
- Coordinate internally and externally
- Indicate common and national specific issues
- Communicate with to outside world – UN bodies, stakeholders, media and others
- Raise and address issues in timely manner
- Improve JI mechanism
- Enhance internal capacity of DFP
- Support post-2012 JI mechanism!!!

Communication Role

DFPs should become more proactive in communicating with JI stakeholders – project participants, AEs and media

DFPs should start internal communication with each other to exchange views, knowledge, experience and lessons learned with the view to enhance and improve JI mechanism

DFP Forum should be able to make joint submissions and communications to relevant UN bodies or relevant entities

JI Promotion Role

DFP Forum should undertake role of promoting JI on national and international level

- Set up work program of DFP Forum
- Develop joint sample JI Promotion Plan for national and international level – Round Tables, Conferences, Web-Seminars, interaction with media and stakeholders
- Establish a mailing list for all DFP and AEIs, if interested
- Develop sample Media Message on JI status in each country
- Ensure continuous news/media interaction flow
- Develop JI post-2012 Road Map and start implementing it

JI Improvement Role

- Establish discussion on current JI National Procedures in each country
- Develop, if possible and appropriate, harmonization of JI Track 1 project procedure
- Enhance interaction with international investors promoting JI Track 1 and Track 2
- Develop sample work plan to enhance transparency and information access for Track 1 projects
- Indicate bottleneck issues and raise them to JISC or Secretariat to be addressed

Capacity Building Role

- Set up continuous communication between DFP – emails and meetings
- Establish experts' network – legal, technical, methodological, etc.
- Establish knowledge share platform (web-based)
- Discover any opportunity to personnel training and exchange experience (World Bank, EBRD, REC, etc.)
