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What are trying to address?

- Enhancing its current efficiency under Art 6
- A new place in anew architecture
- Can collaboration increase and be useful for these two objectives?
- What forms can this collaboration take?

Ideas should be applied to Art 6 with a view to influence the broader architecture



- Compliance buyers may prefer CERs for reputational reasons
- More active dialogue with stakeholders to increase acceptance of JI environmentally, new methodologies
 - With private sector
 - Environmental NGOs
- Discussions of national approval processes
- National roundtables with national and international stakeholders
- Stakeholder participation in JISC processes
- Establish Policy Advisory Panels for Private Sector and Environmental Organizations
- Advisory Panels to be business organized and administered such as BIAC for OECD.
- Self financed and self selected representation



- Establish formal input to the JISC policy process
- What is the status of the Roundtable ?
- How will the input be considered?
- Establish formal direct contact on project specific matters
- Initiated by the regulator
- Ex-ante and ex-post decisions
- Work with private sector to enhance awareness and capacity building
- UNFCCC and Secretariat endorsed RT at the national level
- Hold increasing number of events to explain national processes to investors
 - At Carbon Forums
 - With PS organizations
 - Closer cooperation with national authorities



- Enhance buy-in for the role of JI post 2012
 - Organize events with national business organizations on the benefits of JI
 - Build support with business and environmental NGOs for JI posy-2012 to promote
 - Market liquidity
 - Environmental integrity through consistency
 - Develop a model for JI in a new architecture that allows for fungibility
 - Enter into dialogue with EU and other Parties that may see use for domestic offsets
 - How does JI fit with other alternatives for JI countries



- Identify projects outside traditional JI countries
 - Hold workshops with sectoral associations in non ETS covered sectors
- Better communication through web site and electronic media
 - Press conference after each JISC meeting
- Develop more bottom up methodologies in a collaborative way



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
