Subject: Input for technical workshop 15/16 October 2007

Dear JISC,

With reference to your call for input for the technical workshop on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> of October 2007, I am proposing the following topics:

#### **Input from project developers**

On this first day a round table is organized for AIE and DFP. I propose to organize a round table on the second day to give project developers the possibility to share their experience and suggestions. In particular the following topics could be addressed:

- How workable are the guidelines on criteria for baseline setting and monitoring, in particular when not using existing CDM-methodologies?
- Suggestions for changes to these guidelines;
- What alternatives, compared to the CDM tool, are being used in proving additionality?
- Why have no new projects been forwarded for final determination so far?

#### **Standardized baselines**

Another topic is to facilitate the development of standardized baselines for the electricity grids for all JI Host Countries. Such a topic could very well be raised during the round table with both the AIEs and DFPs. During this discussion the following topics can be raised:

- Whether DFPs would like to have one standardized baseline for their country or would encourage different baselines;
- How AIEs would like to see the process of developing such a baseline and how it should be approved by the Host Country
- Is the JISC is willing to approved such a standardized baseline on its own (so without a particular project attached)

**Other topics**

Further topics could be:

- Experience in making the determination final. Global Carbon has forwarded one project for final determination and plans to forward one or two additional projects soon. With this experience suggestions for improving the review process (if any) can be made by our company;
- Possibility for the JISC to make pre-2008 verification final on a voluntary basis or at least facilitate the publication of the Monitoring and Verification Reports.

We would be happy to make our contribution to the second technological workshop.
