- **Increase transparency/clarity (e.g. regarding application of approved CDM methodologies, including deviations, or JI project specific approaches)**
- **Clear guidance from JISC to IEs and project participants**
- **Common understanding of requirements (project participants and IEs)**
- **Improve consistency in IEs determination work**
