**Content of discussions: Need for revisions to the JI PDD forms (including guidelines for users) based on experiences by IEs and/or project participants**

**Option 1: No need for revisions**

**Possible reasons:**

- **Limited experience**
- **Regulatory stability**
- **Explicit needs would need to be identified**

**Option 2: Need for revisions**

**Possible reasons:**

- **Increased transparency/clarity regarding application of approved CDM methodologies, including deviations, or JI project specific approaches**
- **Reflect relevant changes under the CDM process**

## Option 2 - Suggestions made:

- **Introduction of templates/annexes for:**
  - **Deviations to approved CDM methodology applied**
  - **Description of JI project specific approach**
- **Revisions on the basis of the most recent CDM PDD forms**
- **Alternative to revisions of the JI PDD forms (e.g.further clarifications in the guidelines for users)**

## Option 2 – Process:

- **Needs to be consultative one including stakeholders**
