# JI Track 2 procedure


- Independent determinations/verifications
- Supervision by an international body according to equal rules (Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee)
- Fully operational
- Full transparency

- 12 host Parties indicated in the PDDs submitted for comments










## Publication of project design documents for stakeholders' comments

Expected emission reductions/enhancements of removals during the first commitment period (2008 – 2012): ~ 280 million tonnes CO2 equ.










# Publication of project design documents for stakeholders' comments

## Various technologies:

- Reduction of HFC, PFC and SF6 emissions
- Methane avoidance

#### Relevant sectoral scopes

- 1: Energy industries (renewable/non-renewable sources)
- 4: Manufacturing industries
- 5: Chemical industry
- 8: Mining/mineral production
- 10: Fugitive emissions from fuels (solid, oil and gas)
- 11: Fugitive emissions from production and consumption of halocarbons and sulphur hexafluoride
- 13: Waste handling and disposal

## Accredited independent entities (AIEs)


#### "Montreal decision"

Designated operational entities (DOEs) under the CDM may act provisionally as **AIEs** 

**Determinations/actions valid only** after accreditation

### Accreditation status

- > 15 applications (13 DOEs)
- 14 desk reviews and on-site assessments
- 8 indicative letters issued
- 15 witnessing opportunities accepted from 9 entities
- > 37 experts currently on the roster
