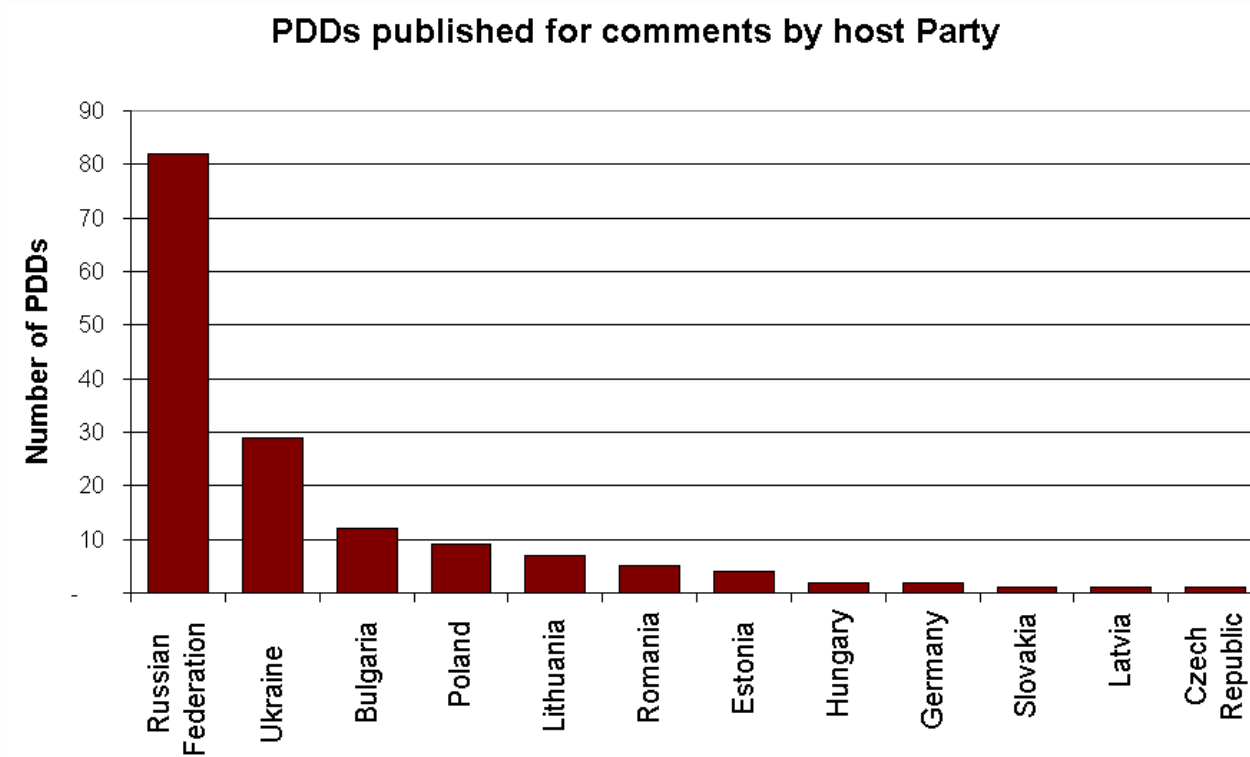

JI Track 2 procedure

- Independent determinations/verifications
- Supervision by an international body according to equal rules
(*Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee*)
- Fully operational
- Full transparency

Publication of project design documents for stakeholders' comments

- **155 PDDs** published for stakeholders' comments (2 open for comments)
- **12 host Parties** indicated in the PDDs submitted for comments

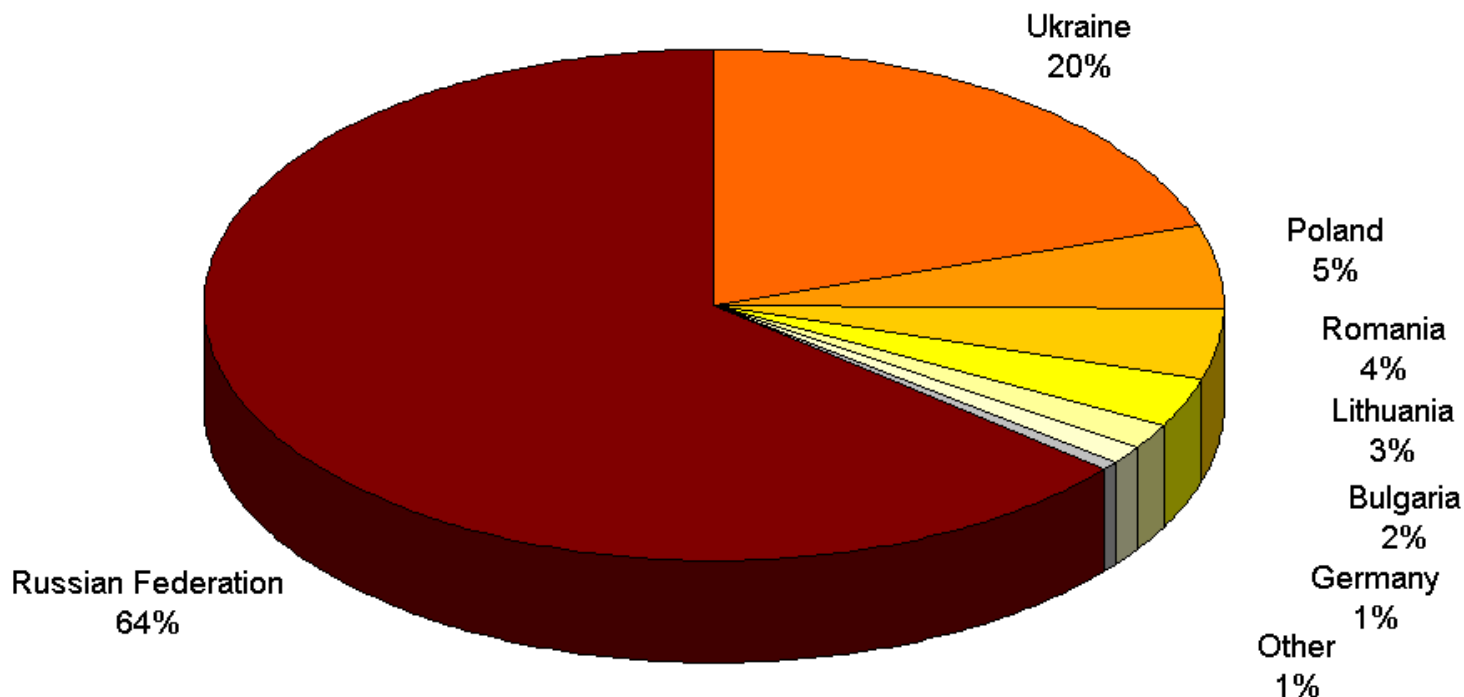

Total emission reductions (2008 - 2012) by host Party

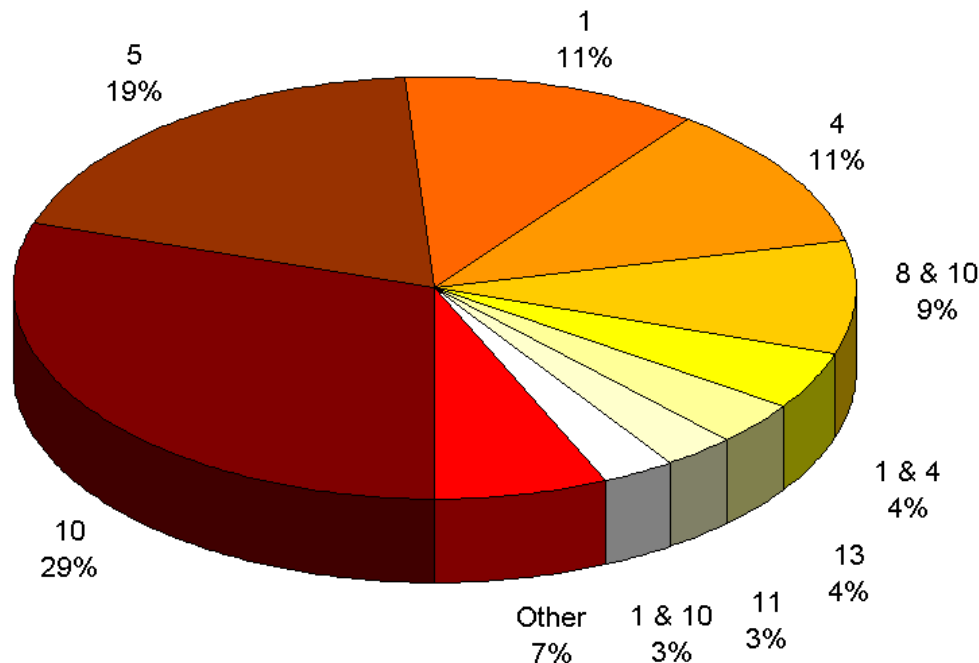


Publication of project design documents for stakeholders' comments

Accredited independent entities (AIEs)

“Montreal decision”

- Designated operational entities (DOEs) under the CDM may act provisionally as AIEs
- Determinations/actions valid only after accreditation

Accreditation status

- 15 applications (13 DOEs)
- 14 desk reviews and on-site assessments
- 8 indicative letters issued
- 15 witnessing opportunities accepted from 9 entities
- 37 experts currently on the roster
