Annual review of the implementation of reliance on the CDM accreditation system

Procedural background

- The JISC, at its 37th meeting agreed that:
 - ✓ All decisions of the CDM EB relating to the CDM accreditation in relation to CDM DOEs shall apply to activities carried out by CDM DOEs acting as AIEs.
 - ✓ The secretariat is to review, annually, the implementation of reliance on the CDM accreditation system and report to the JISC. Such report is to allow the JISC to periodically review the implementation and consider whether to re-introduce a JI-specific accreditation system.
- 10 DOEs have declared voluntarily acting as AIEs (as of 05 September 2020)
