Annual review of the implementation of reliance on the CDM accreditation system

Procedural background

- The JISC, at its 37th meeting:
 - ✓ Agreed that all decisions of the CDM EB relating to the CDM accreditation in relation to CDM DOEs shall apply to activities carried out by CDM DOEs acting as AIEs.
 - ✓ Requested the secretariat to review, annually, the implementation of reliance on the CDM accreditation system and report to the JISC. Such report is to allow the JISC to periodically review the implementation and consider whether to re-introduce a JI-specific accreditation system.
 - ✓ Agreed to require a DOE acting as an AIE to submit a self-declaration annually.



Procedural background

- DOEs have submitted self-declaration in 2021 (as of 25 August 2021).

- Since 2 August 2016, there has been no new determinations and verifications under the JISC (JI Track 2 procedure) submitted by the DOEs acting voluntarily as AIEs.
- The JISC may wish to continue allowing DOEs accredited under the CDM accreditation system to act voluntarily as AIEs under JI.
